

Dear Consignor:

Please find enclosed **Consignment Forms** for the 2008 New Mexico Bred Thoroughbred Yearling Sale, New Mexico Bred Quarter Horse Yearling Sale, and the Select Quarter Horse Yearling Sale. Please submit your entries as early as possible. If you require additional forms they can be reproduced or forms are available for downloading from our website: www.ruidosodownsracing.com.

TB & QH NM BRED YEARLING SALES: Only New Mexico Bred horses are eligible for these sales. Changes in the New Mexico Horse Breeder's Assn. procedures now allow unnamed Thoroughbred horses to have their registration papers stamped with a NMHB number. Therefore, it has been determined that **ALL** yearlings must have an "Accredited New Mexico Bred" number stamped on their papers at time of entry to qualify for cataloguing. If the Registration Papers are received unstamped, the entry is invalid and will be returned to consignor.

BROODMARE and MIXED SALE: Please note that a consignment form & entry fee is required for weanlings to be sold separately from the mare. Only mare/colt combinations **sold as a unit** have one consignment form/entry fee due. It is the responsibility of the consignor to provide the buyer of unregistered and invitro colts with a Breeder's Certificate. Names and addresses of buyers can be obtained from the Sales Office.

ENTRY FEES: The entry fee for the *Ruidoso Select Quarter Horse Yearling Sale* is **\$500.00** if the animal is entered in the **All American Triple Crown** and supplemental payments are current at time of Sale; not entered in Triple Crown - **\$600.00**. *All Sales:* If the entry fee is to be withheld from proceeds, **the original Registration Papers must accompany the consignment form**. A late fee of **\$25.00** is assessed when fees are paid after the deadline. Early consignment would be appreciated. Acceptance of entries for the NM Bred and Broodmare/Mixed Sales is on a first come/first serve basis. Stalls *are* limited.

WITHDRAWALS: Consignor must notify the Sales Office, in writing, of any withdrawal. Please see page #2, Para. #2, (*Consignor's Contract*) of the *Consignment Form* for details of the appropriateness of refunding entry fees. The deadline for withdrawal is the same as the entry deadline.

REGISTRATION PAPERS: Original Registration Papers must be on file at the Sales Office **60 DAYS** prior to Sale date, or the entry cannot be catalogued and the entry fee remains due. All Quarter Horse registration papers must be stamped "Parentage Verified". Check your registration papers for accuracy! A fee of \$125 for completion of the Quarter Horse *Affidavit for Corrected Certificate* and a fee of \$150 for Jockey Club *Corrected Certificate* will be deducted from sale proceeds if papers are found to be in error by the sale inspectors and it is necessary for the sales office to complete and submit these forms to the appropriate breed registry.

TRANSFER REPORTS: AQHA **Transfer Reports** must have original signatures. (AQHA does not allow erasures or alterations.) Transfer reports found on the reverse side of the new Registration Certificates are now acceptable for transferring ownership when the animal is purchased from an auction. Transfer forms are available Online from AQHA's website or via FAX from the Sales Office.

HIP NUMBERING:

Select Sale:

Hip numbering will be conducted by random draw in the Sales Pavilion on July 3 (Rainbow Futurity Trial day) at 8:00am. As in past years, one hip number exchange is permissible within your own entry. Hip numbers will be posted on our website (ruidosodownsracing.com) a day or two after the draw, or you can call the office for the good news. **All requests for hip exchanges must be submitted in writing to the Sales Office no later than July 11.** FAX (575-378-4788) is permissible.

NM Bred TB & QH Yearling & Mixed Sale:

Hip numbering is assigned alphabetically according to the first initial of the dam's name. Random drawing chooses the starting letter of the alphabet and hip numbering progresses via computer, alphabetically from there.

EVA TEST: All horses consigned for any Sale must be tested for Equine Viral Arteritis (EVA) completed within 90 days of the Sale by a diagnostic laboratory, approved by USDA, APHIS-VS to conduct the virus neutralization test for EVA or show proof of vaccination. Copies of these documents are due in the Sales office no later than three weeks prior to sale date; original to be turned in upon arrival.

EVA forms (one per animal) must carry full identification of the horse for sale, including sire/dam, sex, age, and color signed by a veterinarian.

EVA forms (one per animal) must show a specific antibody titer to EVA for any horse that tests serological positive for EVA. Any horse that tests serologically positive as a result of vaccination for EVA shall provide proof of vaccination signed by a veterinarian.

For all male intact horses listed as vaccinated against EVA, the Sale Company requires a copy of negative antibody test for EVA on a blood sample collected prior to vaccination together with written confirmation of EVA vaccination certified by attending veterinarian.

EVA results on all horses consigned for sale are published and made available in the Sale Pavilion each sale day.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES: All horses consigned must be accompanied by a Health Certificate dated within ten (10) days of Sale to be turned into the Sales Office upon arrival at the sale.

COGGINS TEST: A negative Coggins on all horses consigned to the Sale that are over six months of age, dated no earlier than six months prior to the Sale to be turned into the Sales Office upon arrival at the sale.

Failure to submit these documents in a timely manner will result in your animal being disqualified and withdrawn from the Sale with no refund of Consignment Fees.

STALL ASSIGNMENTS:

Stalls will be assigned sometime in July & August for all Sales; assignments will be posted on our website or you may get your stall assignments by calling the Sales Office. Horses will be allowed in their stalls 4-5 days prior to the Sale. The stalls will be adequately bedded once; if you desire additional bedding it can be purchased conveniently. Requests for *special stall assignments* are to be submitted in writing to the Sales Office no later than July 1; we will attempt to satisfy your request if possible.

STALL CARDS:

Stall Cards will be provided at no charge and installed by the Sale staff.

CATALOGS:

Catalogs will be prepared according to information supplied from the enclosed consignment forms. Be sure to fill in the "Consigned By" information exactly as you wish it to appear in the catalog.

Catalog updates for inclusion in the catalog need to be submitted no later than 60 days prior to the sale.

Catalog updates as an announcement will be accepted up until two hours prior to the sale. All updates must be presented to the Sales Office in writing. Update forms are available in the Sales Office, or you may FAX your instructions. *Updates of race performance:* it is the consignor's responsibility to provide chart information for verification of updated race information.

It is the consignor's responsibility to proof the catalog information and notify the Sales Office immediately of any errors or omissions so that we can make the appropriate announcement during the Sale to correct the catalog.

If you desire *proof pages* of your entries, please call Robin Glenn Pedigrees at 405-262-3244 for information. One catalog per consignor will be mailed to you. Agents requiring additional copies: please notify Sales Office 45 days in advance of the Sale. A limited number of copies will be available at the Sale so please bring your copy.

Catalogs will be mailed approximately 3-1/2 weeks prior to each sale.
